NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)

AIVC invites sealed online bids from eligible vendors for the supply of assistive and enabling materials for distribution to beneficiaries under its CSR program. Each item category requires 5,000 units and is aimed at enhancing mobility, accessibility, skilling, and livelihoods.

EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

1. Amount & Mode of Payment:

All participating bidders are required to submit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of ₹7,00,000 (Rupees Seven Lakh only). The payment must be made through online bank transfer to the following account:

2. Refund Policy:

- EMD will be refunded without interest to unsuccessful bidders within 60 working days after the award of the contract.
- The EMD of the successful bidder will be converted into a Performance Security Deposit and retained until the successful completion of all deliverables.

3. Forfeiture of EMD:

The EMD amount will be forfeited in the following cases:

- If the bidder withdraws or modifies the bid after submission but before the tender closing date.
- If the successful bidder fails to sign the contract within 7 working days from the award notification.
- If the selected vendor fails to deliver the goods or comply with the tender obligations within the agreed timelines.
- If any false/misleading information or forged documents are found in the bid.

4. Legal Basis for EMD Charges:

- The Companies Act, 2013 permits Section 8 companies to engage in procurement processes and financial safeguards.
- General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 provide general procurement guidelines, which are followed in setting financial requirements like EMD.
- The Indian Contract Act, 1872 governs the tendering process as a binding contract, allowing AIVC to impose financial security measures such as EMD.
- Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Rules under the Companies Act, 2013 allow & bind Section 8 companies to procure goods and services as per The Indian Contract Act, 1872 for CSR implementation while ensuring transparency and compliance.

SCOPE OF WORK (DETAILED)

The scope of work under this tender covers the **end-to-end procurement**, **packaging**, **delivery**, **and reporting** associated with the following five categories of assistive and enabling materials:

1. Procurement & Supply

- All items should be brand new, unused, and certified by BIS/ISO/CE (as applicable).
- Vendors must ensure goods are sourced from **reputed manufacturers** or OEMs (Original Equipment Manufacturers) with a minimum 1-year warranty.

2. Packaging & Labelling

- Items must be **individually packed** using safe, tamper-proof, and weather-resistant packaging material.
- Each package must carry:

 - Manufacturer details
 - CSR Project branding (AIVC) if required, it will be communicated before finalising the tender with selected vendor.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The bidder must be a registered legal entity in India (Proprietorship, Partnership, LLP, Pvt. Ltd. or Public Ltd. Company, NGO, Trust, or Society) authorized to supply medical/assistive devices or equipment.

- 2. The bidder must possess a valid GST registration and PAN issued by the Income Tax Department and that must be submitted while filling the form.
- 3. Latest GST return filing proof (last 3 months) must be submitted.
- 4. At least 3 years of relevant experience in supplying assistive/rehabilitation equipment or skilling kits.
- 5. Minimum average turnover of 5 crore in the last 3 financial years.
- 6. Must not be blacklisted by any government/CSR entity.
- 7. Proof of similar previous projects, preferably in CSR/government supply.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These terms govern the contract between AIVC and the successful bidder for supply and distribution of enabling materials:

- 1. Delivery Timeline
 - All items must be delivered in full within **90 calendar days or timeline as agreed with AIVC** from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order.
 - o Delays beyond this period without prior written approval will attract penalties.

2. Penalty Clause

- A penalty of **0.5% of the total contract value per week** shall be imposed for late deliveries.
- The maximum penalty shall be **10% of the total contract value**, beyond which the contract may be terminated.

3. Packaging & Labelling

- Each unit must be packaged securely to ensure damage-free delivery.
- Items must be labelled in both English and Hindi and if required bearing the CSR campaign name: "AIVC Initiative."

4. Warranty & Replacement

- o A minimum Six months/One-year warranty is mandatory on all supplied items.
- Defective or malfunctioning items reported within the warranty period must be replaced within **30 working days** of notification, at no additional cost.

5. Inspection & Quality Control

- AIVC reserves the right to inspect items at any stage (production, packing, pre-dispatch, or post-delivery).
- Any consignment failing to meet the specified quality standards will be rejected and must be replaced within the stipulated time.

6. Payment Terms

- **100% payment** will be made within **15 working days** after successful delivery, inspection, and receipt of the invoice and delivery reports.
- \circ $\;$ No advance payment will be made under any circumstances.

7. EMD and Performance Security

- The EMD of INR 7,00,000/- submitted by the successful bidder shall be retained as Performance Security Deposit and will be refunded after 90 days of final supply and acceptance.
- EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be refunded within 30 days from tender finalization.

8. Termination of Contract

- AIVC may terminate the contract with **15 days notice** if the bidder fails to meet any contractual obligations.
- \circ $\;$ In such cases, the Performance Security will be forfeited.

9. Right to Accept or Reject

- AIVC reserves the full right to accept or reject any or all bids, in part or full, without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- AIVC may call samples for technical evaluation.
- AIVC reserves right to call for Negotiations after Financial Bid opening.

10. Arbitration & Jurisdiction

- Any disputes arising shall be subject to arbitration in New Delhi and governed by the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- Courts of New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

Initial delivery will be made to AIVC's storage hubs and Final distribution to beneficiaries will be coordinated by AIVC.
