Expression of Interest (EoI) for submission of proposals under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY 2.0) in the State of Chhattisgarh

Chhattisgarh Gramin Aajeevika Samvardhan Samiti (CGSRLM -Bihan) invites proposal from registered Project Implementation Agencies (PIAs with valid PRN number with MoRD, Govt.of India) under DDUGKY 2.0 scheme to allot target of skilling of 2021candidates (including 500 for captive employer and 101 for Person with Disabilities) for the Financial Year 2025-26.

- 1. Interested project implementing agencies (PIAs) may apply against this EoI to implement project as:
- a. As captive employer with a target of 500 rural youth- The Captive employer should be a PIA empanelled with MoRD as per Notification18/2020 dated 6th October 2020 issued by Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India.
- b. Under PWD category -For Persons with Disabilities with minimum target of 101 reserved under the PWD Category. The PWD Category Guidelines will be applicable as per the notification no.43/2017.
- 2. Interested project implementing agencies may submit their proposals online at kaushal.rural.gov.in along with non-refundable application fee of Rs. 25,000/- plus taxes (if applicable) to be paid in the following bank.

Apart from the above fees a separate Project qualitative appraisal non-refundable fee would be applicable to those projects which are recommended for qualitative appraisal in initial screening stage. The amount of the fee would be notified separately. Applicant PIA should read the guidelines and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) of DDU- GKY 2.0 carefully before filling up the application.

- 3. Proposals should be submitted online on MoRD ERP portal on or before 15.06.2025, 05.00 PM. Applications received after the scheduled date and time shall not be considered.
- 4. It is to be noted that the agencies applying for the DDUGKY project shall bear the expenses as detailed above for undertaking the project appraisal by agency on behalf of CGSRLM-Bihan. Under DDUGKY 2.0 project, agencies that can train and place candidates according to the skill gap existing in different sectors are encouraged to apply.

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- 5. In order to be eligible to apply for a project, an entity should be:-
- a. Registered under Indian Trust Acts or any State Society Registration Act or any State Co-operative Societies Act or Multi-State Co-operative Acts or the Companies Act 2013 or the Limited Liability Partnerships Act 2008, or SHGs and its federations namely Cluster Level Federation/Block Level Federations;
- b. A Government or semi-government organization at the State and National Levels
- c. NGOs must be registered with NITI Aayog's Darpan Portal
- d. Should be more than three years old at the time of application except Start-ups

6. There shall be four categories of PIA as mentioned in the Guidelines of DDUGKY 2.0

- a. Priority A-Captive Employers
 - (Captive employer is any Employer/Industry who provides employment to candidates in their own organization or one of its subsidiaries and have suitable inhouse training facilities.)
- b. **Priority B-**Existing PIAs (Across PAN INDIA) having experience of greater than 50% placement with DDU-GKY
- c. Priority C-Skilling Agencies who do not have any DDU-GKY experience
- d. Priority D-Start-ups for Skilling recognized by Dept. of Industrial Policy & Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, GoI
 (Start ups are applicable as per The Gazette of India Notification dated: 19th Feb., 2019,released under Ministry of Commerce and Industry- Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade.
- 7. All agencies must generate the new PRN through https:kaushal.rural.gov.in for DDUGKY 2.0 under categories A, B, C and D.
- 8. The following shall not be eligible for applying as PIAs in DDU-GKY:-
- a. Existing PIAs who got DDU-GKY Projects sanctioned and have recovery proceedings going on anywhere in India.
- b. Existing PIAs (PAN India-all States) who were unable to place minimum 50% of trained candidates under DDU-GKY.
- c. Skilling agencies having officials at key managerial personnel as per accounting standard 18, who were earlier associated with defaulting PIAs against whom recovery proceedings were initiated due to default.
- d. Sister concern/subsidiary of any organization against whom default action for recovery of funds initiated.
- e. Skilling Agencies having Directors involved in agencies that defaulted earlier with DDU-GKY. A provision shall be built into the system for validating the DIN of directors of the applicant organization through Ministry of Corporate Affairs database.
- f. Skilling Agencies blacklisted by any State Govt. or Govt. of India.
- g. No consortium is allowed for this EoI.
- 9. Project implementing agencies are required to strictly follow the DDUGKY 2.0 Guidelines, Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), Notifications/Order as notified by the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD, GoI) and Chhattisgarh State Rural Livelihood Mission (Bihan) from time to time.

- 10. Applicant agency can apply for any districts from any category. However, it is encouraged that successful agencies opt for Aspirational districts and Tribal area districts for target allotment. Allotment of the districts will be done by CGSRLM based on the requirement/demand.
- 11. All selected PIAs have to complete the training target by 31st December,2025 and complete appointment of all the trained candidates by 31st March, 2026.
- 12. The entire process of application of proposal, screening and selection will be done strictly as per the guidelines and norms laid out by MoRD, GoI.
- 13. CGSRLM reserves the rights regarding
 - a. Allotment of Targets/Districts/Sectors/Trades.
 - b. Accept/reject the proposal.
 - c. To award project with modification to the proposal before sanctioning the project.
