1.0 GENERAL

Bidders are advised to acquaint themselves fully with the description of work, scope of services, time schedule and terms and conditions including all the provisions of the bid document before framing up their bid.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

Introduction

The objective of this program is to mobilize, train, and create awareness among farmers about the value addition of banana pseudo stem and its potential products. The program aims to enhance farmers' income by introducing them to innovative uses and processing techniques for banana pseudo stem, which is often considered agricultural waste

Objectives

1. Mobilize Farmers:

- o Identify and engage farmers growing bananas in the target region.
- o Encourage participation through awareness campaigns and community meetings.

2. Training:

- Provide comprehensive training on the processing and value addition of banana pseudo stem.
- Teach farmers the technical skills required to produce marketable products from banana pseudo stem.
- Training to enhance farmers' knowledge and skills in modern banana cultivation practices in certain areas where its required.

3. Awareness:

- Raise awareness about the economic benefits and environmental sustainability of utilizing banana pseudo stem.
- o Educate farmers on market opportunities and potential revenue streams from value-added products.

4. Target Audience

- o Banana farmers in the target region.
- o Agricultural cooperatives and farmer groups.
- o Local community leaders and influencers.



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Program Components

1. Mobilization:

I. Community Meetings:

o Organize initial community meetings to introduce the program and its benefits.

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4. Expected Outcomes

- o Enhanced skills and technical expertise in processing and value addition techniques.
- o Improved economic conditions for farmers through additional income streams.
- Promotion of sustainable agricultural practices by utilizing banana pseudo stem waste.

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3.0 SUBMISSION OF BIDS

Bid shall be submitted along with Tender Fees, Earnest Money Deposit and other requisite documents in sealed envelopes as cover-I (Technical bid) & cover-II (financial bid) super scribed thereon name of the work. Both covers I & II shall be enclosed in a separate cover / envelope superscribed "Farmers' Mobilization, Training, and Awareness Program on Value Addition of Banana Pseudo Stem and Its Products"

- Cover -I (Technical Bid): Forwarding letter, Signed-sealed copies bid document, Business Registration Details, Certificate of Registration for GST, PAN Card of the firm / Agency, Partnership Deed in case of partnership firm and Articles of Association in case of limited Company, Work Completion Certificate, CA Certified Turn Over statement and all other relevant documents including the tender fees and earnest money & qualifying / eligibility criteria proof.
- Cover-II (Financial Bid): The bid shall contain the offered price with the full Bid Document duly filled as per the format given in this bid document & a cover letter for financial bid. No other condition stipulated in Cover-II, other than unconditional general rebate, shall be accepted. All pages of the Bid Document should have original signature with official seal of the bidder.

After examining the Cover-I (Technical Bids) of the bid, NECTAR will open the Cover-II (Financial Bids) of only those eligible bidders who have satisfied the requirements of Cover-I along with EMD & Tender Value on the same day or on another day.

- All pages of the original bid document should be signed with official seal.
- Covering letters and other detailed documents should form part of the offer.

4.0 DEVIATIONS TO EOI CLAUSES

Bidders are advised to submit the bids strictly based on the terms and conditions and specification contained in the Bid Documents and not to stipulate any deviations. Conditional bids are liable to be rejected.

5.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER

Bids submitted by bidders shall remain valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of the bids. The bidder shall not be entitled, during the said period of 90 days, to revoke or cancel their bid or to vary the bid price given or any term thereof, without the consent in writing of the Owner. In case of bidder revoking or cancelling their bids or varying any terms & price of an item in regard thereof without the consent of owner in writing, NECTAR shall reject their bid forfeiting the EMD paid by them along with their bid without giving any notice.



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6.0 AWARD OF WORK

NECTAR reserves the right to engage one or more parties to award the work for separate locations. Work shall be awarded to the lowest bidder, subject to the work experience and fulfilment of other terms & conditions and specifications. Bidder may opt for one location or multiple location for training & awareness

7.0 ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION OF BID

- NECTAR does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid. i).
- ii). NECTAR also reserves the right to accept or reject any bid in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- NECTAR also reserves the absolute right to reject any or all the bids at iii). any time solely based on the past unsatisfactory performance by the bidder(s) the opinion/decision of NECTAR regarding the same shall be final and conclusive.

8.0 **CORRECTIONS**

No corrections or overwriting will be entertained in schedule of rates by using correcting fluid. All corrections in the schedule of rate should be made by penning through the error and writing the corrected figure / words in legible handwriting by the side of correction duly initialed with date and stamped.

9.0 FIRM RATES

The rates quoted by the bidder shall remain firm till completion of all works even during the extended period, if any, on any account whatsoever. It may be noted that no deviation on this account will be acceptable and an offer not containing a firm price shall not be considered.

- 6. **CODE OF ETHICS:** The bidders should observe the highest standard of ethics and should not indulge in the following prohibited practices, either directly or indirectly, at any stage during the procurement process or during execution of resultant contracts:
 - "Corrupt practice": making offers, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, rewards or gifts or any material benefit, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process or contract execution.
 - "Fraudulent practice": any omission or commission or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefits may be obtained or an obligation avoided. This includes making false declaration or providing false information for participation in the bidding process or to secure a contract or in execution of the contract.
 - "Anti-competitive practice": any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive arrangement, or any other practice coming under the purview of The Competition Act, 2002, between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of NECTAR, that may impair the transparency, fairness and the ss or to establish bid prices at artificial,

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d. "Coercive practice": harming or threatening to harm, persons or their property to influence their participation in the procurement process or affect the execution of a contract;

In case it comes to the notice of NECTAR at any stage that a bidder has indulged in any corrupt/ fraudulent/ anti-competitive/coercive practice:

- i) Will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent or anti-competitive or coercive and unlawful practices in competing for the contract in question.
- ii) Will declare the bidder not eligible and blacklist for a period of three years from being awarded a contract, if it at any time determines that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent or anti-competitive or coercive and unlawful practices in competing for or in executing, a contract.
- 7. It will be obligatory on the part of the bidder to sign the bid documents. After the work is awarded, he will have to enter into an agreement on proforma to be provided by NECTAR for work awarded, on a non-judicial stamp paper of requisite value at his own cost within ten days from date of receipt of acceptance work order.
- 8. Any addendum/ corrigendum issued shall form a part of the bid document. There will not be any press notification on amendment/ corrigendum. The prospective bidders are required to visit NECTAR Website i.e. www.nectar.org.in and on <a href="www.



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GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1. All communication and information should be provided in writing.
- 2. NECTAR reserves the right to reject the offer submitted in response to this EOI any stage without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
- 3. NECTAR reserves the right to change any or all the provisions of the EOI document, such changes would be intimated to all the parties participating in the process.
- 4. Any addendum/corrigendum/date extension etc. in respect of this bid shall be issued on our website https://nectar.org.in only. No separate notification shall be issued in the press. Bidders are, therefore, requested to visit our website regularly to keep them updated.
- 5. The work should be completed within 90 days from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent / Work Order.
- 6. Time is the essence of the contract. If the Firm/Agency delay in the progress of work due to circumstances beyond their control, they shall have to apply in writing with proper justification for the delay to the NECTAR for extension of time of completion within 3 (three) days of such occurrence but before expiry of stipulated date of completion. The NECTAR Authority on such application, may grant the extension of time. If they think it justified after proper enquiries. However, the finding of the NECTAR will be final and must be abided by the Agency.
- 7. Income Tax deduction will be made at source as per laid down rules of Ministry of Finance, Govt.
- 8. The rate quoted by the agency shall be firm throughout the tenure of the contract and shall be inclusive of all taxes, octroi and other statutory payments and will not subject to any fluctuation due to any increase in any effect.
- 9. The payment of bill will be made on actuals against Final Bill.
- 10. The Agency shall not, without the written consent and approval of the NECTAR, Sublet any part of the work.
- 11. No other terms and conditions are acceptable from their end if not stipulated in the work order or accepted. The Bidder, at the Bidder's own responsibility, cost and risk, is required to visit and examine the Site of Works and its surroundings, investigation report, existing works, if any, connected to this work, and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for execution of the work. The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.
- 12. The bidder is expected, before quoting his rate, to go through the requirement of materials / workmanship, specification, requirements and conditions of contract.
- 13. NECTAR reserves the right to impose penalty on the contractor for each day of delay beyond the specified date of completion, subject to the total amount of Damages not exceeding 10 (ten) per cent of the Contract Price.



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- 14. COMPLETION REPORT Wherever applicable, the firm/agency shall have to submit with the final bill, detailed report showing the works completed in all respects. Such report shall consist of one original and three copies of the same. Unless such report is furnished and approved, payment for final bill will not be processed.
- 15. Any delays in or failure of the performance of either party herein shall not constitute default there under or give rise to any claim for damages, if any, to the extent such delays or failure of performance is caused by occurrences such as Act of god or the public enemy, expropriation or confiscation of facilities by Government authorities, or in compliance with any order or request of any Governmental authorities or due acts of war, rebellion or sabotage or fires, floods, explosions, riots or illegal joint strikes of all the workers of all the contractors.
- 16. The Firm/Agency shall comply with the Labour laws in force. No Labour below the age of eighteen years shall be employed on the works. The bidder should make their own arrangement for the assign all Labour trained in the particular field of work preferably local.
- 17. No claim for interest will be entertained by NECTAR in respect of any balance payments or any deposits which may be held up with NECTAR.
- 18. Any dispute, controversy, difference of any kind whatsoever or claim arising out of or in relation to this Agreement or the breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, shall be settled amicably by negotiation between the Parties. In event no amicable resolution or settlement is reached within a period of thirty (30) days from date on which above-mentioned dispute or difference arose, such dispute or difference shall be resolved by moving appropriate application/petition for appointment of sole Arbitrator before Meghalaya High Court. The seat of Arbitration shall be at Shillong and arbitration shall be conducted in English language. The arbitration will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or of any modifications or re-enactments thereof. The arbitral award will be final and binding on the parties, subject to legal remedies available under the law. The venue of Arbitration & Jurisdiction will be Meghalaya High Court.



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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Bidders shall submit their bids for the complete scope of work as defined in the bid documents.
- 2. However, NECTAR reserves the right to split up the work, evaluate and award works to one or more Bidders, without prejudice to any provisions made elsewhere in the bid documents.
- 3. All terms and conditions of the bid documents shall be construed as applicable for any or all parts of the works, in general, unless specifically indicated to the contrary. The provisions as separately applicable in case of sub-division of the works, are set out separately, wherever applicable.
- 4. The Bidder shall quote prices valid for acceptance by the NECTAR for award of full or part of the works, Bidder shall categorically confirm in their offer, their acceptance to the provisions of this clause.
- 5. Contract documents for agreement shall be executed after award of works to the successful bidder by Intent or work order. Until the final contract documents are prepared and executed this bid document together with the annexed documents, modifications, deletions agreed upon by the NECTAR and Bidder's acceptance thereof, shall constitute a binding contract between the successful bidder and the NECTAR, based on terms contained in the aforesaid documents and the finally submitted and accepted prices.
- 6. The selected agency must pay Earnest Money of requisite amount failing which the tender is liable to be rejected.
- 7. No interest shall be paid by the NECTAR on the Earnest Money deposited by the selected agency.
- 8. The Earnest Money deposited by selected agency shall be forfeited in case the selected bidder fails to start work within a period of 10 days.
- 9. The successful tender shall be issued LOI / LOA. The duplicate copy of the LOA will be returned duly signed by the agency as a token of acceptance.
- 10. The work order / LOI duly signed by the NECTAR & successful bidder will be treated as agreement between the parties. In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to sign the work order / LOA within 10 days' time from the receipt of the work order / LOA. The earnest money deposit may be forfeited.
