1.0 BACKGROUND

1.1 About REIL:

Rajasthan Electronics & Instruments Limited (REIL), Jaipur is a rapidly growing "Mini Ratna" since 1997, Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) under the administrative control of Department of Heavy Industry, Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises, Government of India; with the aim to undertake manufacturing and development of professional grade electronic equipments and solutions in the area of Dairy, Renewable Energy and IT solutions. - 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, than agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4. All the Bidders meeting the eligibility criteria defined under this Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) shall be short-listed for further process. REIL may select one or more training partners against this NIT. If required for smooth execution of project, work can be split in ratio of 70:30 or 50:30:20 or any other ratio subject to maximum allotment to L1 Party.
- 5. Interested bidders may download the Notice for NIT document from the website of the Company www.reiljp.com and e-proc. The prospective agencies desirous of participating may view and download the document free of cost from the website of REIL. However bidders need to submit the document fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) through DD/NEFT/RTGS in favour of Rajasthan Electronics & Instruments limited payable at Jaipur from any nationalized bank, and submit its copy along with the response (Exempted for MSME Units subject to submission of valid UAN certificate). - 9. <u>OPENING OF BID</u>: Opening of bid will be done at time and date notified in the bid. The decision of the evaluation committee on technical suitability shall be final & binding.
- 10. The two-stage procedure shall be adopted that will proceed as follows:
- 11. The first stage proposal will consist of Technical Bid & second stage will be the Commercial Bid. Commercial Bids of only technically qualified Bidders based on evaluation of the Technical Bid shall be opened. A decision as to whether or not a Bidder will be technically qualified will be based on the Bidder's experience, financial standings, technical and general capabilities as demonstrated by Bidder's response to the requirements of this RFP document.

20. No Near Relative Clause

The bidder should give a certificate that none of his/her near relative is working in REIL as defined below along with their technical bid as per Annexure-5. For partnership firm certificate will be given by all the partners and in case of limited company by all the Directors of the company excluding Government of India/Financial institution nominees and independent non-Official part time Directors appointed by Govt. of India or the Governor of the state and full time Directors of PSUs both state and central. In case of Trust /Society, certificate will be given by working president .Due to any breach of these conditions by the Company or firm or any other person the tender will be cancelled and Bid Security will be forfeited at any stage whenever it is noticed and REIL will not pay any damage to the company or firm or the concerned person. The company or firm or the person will also be debarred for further participation in the REIL Tenders. The near relatives for this purpose are defined as:- (a) Members of a Hindu undivided family. (b) They are husband and wife. (c) The one is related to the other in the manner as father, mother, son(s) & Son's wife (daughter in law), Daughter(s) and daughter's husband (son in law), brother(s) and brother's wife, sister(s) and sister's husband (brother in law).

3.2 Eligibility Criteria

The participation in the NIT is invited from reputed Parties/ Trust/Societies who meet all the following criteria.

i. The Lead Firm/Bidder should be a Company registered under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 or Companies Act, 2013.

Or

The Lead Firm/Bidder should be a Firm/LLP/Proprietorship/Trust/Society. In case of a consortium, registration certificate, agreement & all relevant documents of their partnership of all the consortium members shall be provided.



- ii. The Lead Firm/Bidder should have a minimum average turnover of Rs. 100 Lakh or above in last 3 financial years (2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22).
- iii. The Lead Firm/Bidder should have a valid PAN number & GST number
- iv. The Bidder should have valid NSDC'S Accreditated Centre/S to Be Affiliated Training Partners (ATP). In case of Consortium, any one firm in the Consortium should have NSDC's Accredited Centers.
- v. The ATP should have experienced to provide capacity building /training not less than 1000 participants/youths in last three years. The ATP should have provided placement to not less than 700 participants in last 3 year in relevant sectors as per Government/NSDC guidelines.
- vi. Necessary manpower to complete the works assigned, with documentary evidence for the same to be submitted along with this NIT.
- vii. The Lead Firm/Bidder should have established office and/or other infrastructure in the respective state.
- viii. The Lead Firm/Bidder should have minimum 5 (Five) established office/training infrastructure in respective state.
- ix. The Bidder shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt or fraudulent practices or blacklisted with any of the Government agencies as on the due date for submission of bid. Self Certificate on Rs. 50/- Non Judicial Stamp for Eligibility Criteria.

 In the case of Consortium, all firms in the consortium must provide similar declaration on Rs. 50/- Non Judicial Stamp for Eligibility Criteria.
- x. Preference will be given to the REIL registered vendors.

3.3 General Instructions

- 1. Selected Bidders/Training Partners (TP) shall agree to work in the respective state/states only in which applied for.
- 2. The bidder shall be required to make presentations related to the information sought in response to this NIT, if so requested by REIL.
- 3. The bidder shall bear all the costs for participation in the bid process including preparation of responses to the NIT and must be ready to undertake this activity on its own.
- 4. The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any ministry from the country, Government department or customer of the Central of state Government of the country. This undertaking becomes the part of the Cover-note.



- 4. Any false information provided in the NIT with respect to citations, Projects handled, Office locations or any other information if found out incorrect by REIL, would lead to disqualification of the bidder and other suitable penal actions.
- 6. This NIT does not constitute and will not be deemed to constitute any commitment on part of REIL for any purchase/work order.

7. Security Deposit (SD)

Within Fifteen (15) days from date of the issue of notification of award by the Purchaser, the bidder, shall furnish Security Deposit to the Purchaser for an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total value of the contract, valid up to 60 days after the date of completion of work / all contractual obligations by the bidder.

The Performance security shall be denominated in Indian Rupees.

It shall be in any one of the forms namely Account Payee Demand Draft drawn from any nationalized/scheduled bank in India or Bank Guarantee issued by a nationalized/scheduled bank in India, in favour of the Purchaser. The validity of Bank Guarantee will be for a period up to sixty (60) days beyond respective Warranty Period.

In the event of any failure /default of the supplier with or without any quantifiable loss to the Purchaser the amount of the Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited. The Purchaser may do the needful to cover any failure/default of the supplier with or without any quantifiable loss to the Purchaser.

8. In case of any ambiguity/ dispute in the interpretation of any of the clauses in this NIT Document, REIL interpretation of the clauses shall be final and binding on all Applicants/parties

9. EXCLUSIVITY:

During the validity period of MoU, unless with the previous written consent of the other Party to the contrary, the Parties shall not enter into any similar agreement/ Memorandum of Understanding of any nature in respect of the Project and/ or discuss matters concerned under this Agreement, either directly or indirectly or through its subsidiary/ associate or otherwise with any other party (ies).



3.4 Payment terms and condition

a) All the funds will be received in the REIL account, and REIL will make the payment to its Training Partner bank account only, as per the milestones, terms & condition and MoU after deducting the % offering to REIL.

- b) Payment to the Training partner will be released only on receipt of payment in the REIL account from the respective agency/department on completion of each stage of the project.
- c) Training Partner will raise the invoice to REIL for payment on completion of agreed milestones for release of payment.
- d) All taxes and duties if any will be applicable, GST exempted organization should submit exemption certificate.
- e) Any discrepancy found in financial audit/verification of statement to REIL must be corrected and payment to be revised accordingly.

3.5 Disqualification

- 1. REIL shall not consider for the purpose of qualification, NIT, which is found to be incomplete in content and/ or attachments and/ or authentication, etc.
- 2. Without prejudice, a sole Firm or a consortium may be disqualified and its NIT dropped from further consideration for, but not limited to, any of the reasons listed below:
 - Failure by the parties mentioned above to provide necessary and sufficient information required to be provided in the NIT; (or)
 - Parties convicted by a Court of law; (or)
 - Parties against whom any adverse order has been passed by a regulatory authority that casts a doubt on the ability of the party to manage large works.

3.6 Governing language

The contract shall be written in English. All correspondence and other documents pertaining to the contract, which the parties exchange, shall also be written accordingly in that language.

3.7 Notices

Notice, if any, relating to the contract given by one party to the other, shall be sent in writing or by cable and confirmed in writing. The procedure will also provide the sender of the notice, the



proof of receipt of the notice by the receiver. The addresses of the parties for exchanging such notices will be the addresses as incorporated in the contract. The effective date of a notice shall be either the date when delivered to the recipient or the effective date specifically mentioned in the notice, whichever is later.

3.8 Resolution of disputes

Except as hereinbefore provided, any dispute arising out of this Agreement, the same shall be referred to the arbitration of two arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party to the dispute, and in case of difference of opinion between them to an umpire appointed by the said two arbitrators before entering on the reference, and the decision of such arbitrators or umpire, as the case may be, shall be final and binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at Jaipur, Rajasthan and the arbitration proceedings shall take place under the Indian Arbitration Act, 1996.

3.9 Applicable Law

This contract and its validity, interpretation and performance will take effect and be governed under the laws of India. Venue in any action in law or equity arising from the terms and conditions of this contract shall be the court of appropriate jurisdiction in Jaipur, Rajasthan (India).

3.10 Risk and Cost

Risk and Cost the event of failure on the part of the vendor in the services, which is required in view of the pending orders, REIL shall be entitled to cancel the remaining work order and take the services through other sources at risk and costs of the vendor.

- 3.11 The bidder may be terminated /exited from the contract and can be further blacklisted by REIL, any one of the following reasons, if the bidder at any stage of the tender i.e. tender process, tender award, and tender execution:
 - Any misinformation, misrepresentation, breach or violation of the terms of this Agreement by either of the Parties;



ii. If the bidder deviates from or not fulfills his scope of work in the given timeline in the award.

3.12 Indemnity



- 2.1.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to the Principal or to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material, immaterial or any other benefit which he / she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
- 2.1.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- 2.1.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not commit any penal offence under the relevant IPC/ PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- 2.1.4 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the agent(s)/ representative(s) in India if any. Similarly the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principal(s) if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agent of Foreign Suppliers" shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). Further as mentioned in the guidelines all the payments made to the Indian Agent/ Representative have to be in Indian Rupees only.
- 2.1.5 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- 2.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.



Section 3 – Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 above, or acts in any other manner such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidders(s)/ Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the separate "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/ Contractors" framed by the Principal.

Section 4 – Compensation for Damages

- 4.1 If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security.
- 4.2 If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages equivalent to 5% of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee, whichever is higher.

Section 5 – Previous Transgression

- 5.1 The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- 5.2 If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.

Section 6 – Equal treatment of all Bidders/ Contractors/ Sub-contractors

- 6.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from his sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. This commitment shall be taken only from those sub-contractors whose contract value is more than 20% of Bidder's/ Contractor's contract value with the Principal.
- 6.2 The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 6.3 The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7 – Criminal Charges against violating Bidders/ Contractors Subcontractors

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which



constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to Vigilance Office.

Section 8 –Independent External Monitor(s)

8.1 The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.

- 8.2 The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the MD, REIL.
- 8.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all contract documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will grant the monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his contract documentation. The same is applicable to Sub-contractor(s). The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) / Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality.
- 8.4 The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the contract provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- 8.5 As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 8.6 The Monitor will submit a written report to the MD, REIL within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.



8.7 If the Monitor has reported to the MD, REIL, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC / PC Act, and the MD, REIL has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.

8.8 The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 – Pact Duration

- 9.1 This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the respective contract and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.
- 9.2 If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified as above, unless it is discharged/ determined by the MD, REIL.

Section 10 – Other Provisions

- 11.1 This agreement is subject to Indian Laws and jurisdiction shall be registered office of the Principal, i.e. Jaipur.
- 11.2 Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 11.3 If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 11.4 Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 11.5 Only those bidders/ contractors who have entered into this agreement with the Principal would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this agreement would be a preliminary qualification.
